Food bank donations needed

Hamilton Food Share's annual holiday food drive is in full swing with the collection of non-perishable food and money across the city.

More than 18,400 Hamiltonians use food banks every month and more than 30,000 are expected to access a food bank this holiday season, said Hamilton Food Share executive director Joanne Santucci.

The goal is to help feed more than 8,500 children and their families by distributing the donations among food banks across the city. The drive began Dec. 1 and continues until Dec. 23.
